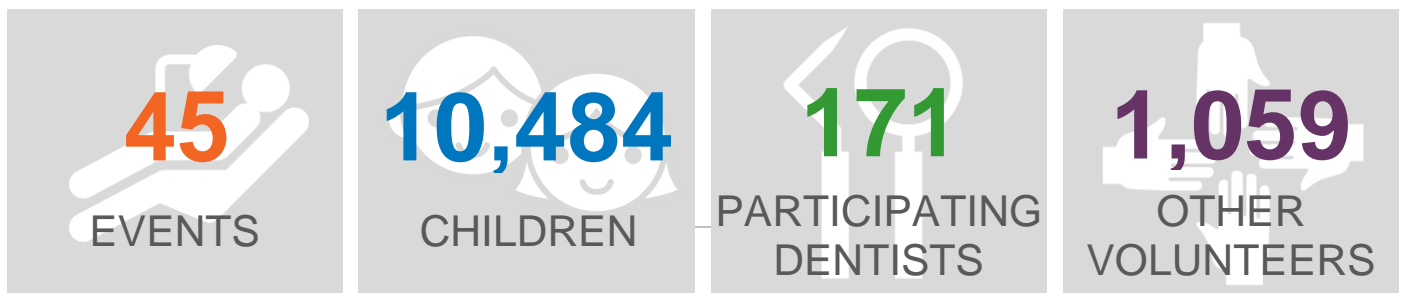
Investing in better oral health for all. Together.

The ADA Foundation provided **\$3 million** in grants, awards, and scholarships, and facilitated in-kind oral healthcare product donations in 2017.

In 2017 alone, the ADA Foundation's Give Kids A Smile® program mobilized approximately 6,600 dentists and 24,000 other volunteers to provide oral health services to 285,000 children through 1,300 GKAS events throughout the United States.
