The ADA Foundation Crest and Oral-B Promising Researcher Award

Background: Financial support for young researchers in the field of oral health is critical to their professional development, and should begin early in their training. One way to provide that much-needed support and encouragement, is the establishment of the “ADA Foundation Crest and Oral-B Promising Researcher Award.”

Purpose: The ADA Foundation Crest and Oral-B Promising Researcher Award promotes and recognizes excellence in oral health research by providing financial assistance for promising researchers to pursue a career in research that advances preventive dentistry.

Focus: Oral health research on prevention – not limited to basic and translational research, but also including clinical research.

Award Description: The annual ADA Foundation Crest and Oral-B Promising Researcher Award will provide \$5,000 to one individual to attend a scientific conference or conferences to further his/her knowledge or skills, and/or to present his/her findings at such scientific conference.

The award funds can be used to pay for expenses to attend and/or to present at scientific conference(s)

- Registration fees,
- Travel expenses,
- Meals, and
- Lodging, if applicable.

With approval from the selection committee, the award money may also be used to cover research related expenses. A written summary of how the award funds would be used must accompany the application at the time of submission.

Eligibility: Degree candidates must be U.S. citizens who conduct oral health research in preventive dentistry while enrolled in one of the following degree programs at an eligible institution*:

- D.D.S. or D.M.D.
- D.D.S./D.M.D. and Ph.D. dual degree

- Ph.D. or equivalent
- M.P.H., M.S. or equivalent

*Eligible institution is an accredited public, nonprofit, or privately owned profit making college, university, vocational school, or postsecondary education institution that is eligible to participate in a student aid program administered by the U.S. Department of Education

Application Requirements: Individuals must complete the electronic application and upload all required attachments that include:

- Curriculum vitae
- Abstract
- Two letters of recommendation
- Any other supporting documentation

Proof of Conference Attendance and Report Submission Requirements: ADAF will require the Award recipient to submit the followings:

1. Proof of attendance
2. Report containing a narrative account of activities.

Acknowledgement by the Recipient: If the research supported by the Award leads to a research report intended for publication, it is required that the Award recipient author notify the ADA Foundation. The ADA Foundation will inform Procter & Gamble of the upcoming research publication. It is expected that the Award recipient acknowledge the research is partially funded by the grant from ADA Foundation.

Application Deadline: All applications must be received by **11:59 pm CDT May 31, 2019**. Incomplete application materials will not be considered. By submitting this application, all components, including attachments, may be used by the ADA Foundation for promotional use.

****A confirmation receipt is emailed at the time of submission to the applicant. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that materials have been submitted and confirmed through the online system by the published deadline.*
