

2019 International Dental Volunteer Project Grant

ADA Foundation

Question Group

The American Dental Association Foundation is in the second year of a new grant program to support existing international dental volunteer projects. The ADAF is keenly aware of the value to both recipients as well as participants of these projects. As part of a two year pilot, the Foundation made five \$5,000 grants in 2018 and plans to make four \$5,000 grants in 2019.

Purpose: The purpose of the ADA Foundation's Grant Program for International Dental Volunteer Projects is to support U.S. based organizations that are working to improve access to oral health care in underserved communities outside the U.S.

Eligibility Requirements:

- All projects must be themselves, or associated with, a US-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization or foundation. All awards will be made to the 501 (c)(3) organization, not to individual applicants.
- All projects must have a demonstrable current three-year history of activity (2015-2018). The recipient organization must lead dental trips of at least one week duration per year and may be service oriented, dental education/oral health oriented, or a combination project.
- All awardees agree to provide reporting as stipulated in the application process and be willing for the ADAF to use appropriate photos and other project information from the awarded project for informational and promotional purposes.

Dollar Amounts and Number of Grants Available: Four grants of up to \$5,000 each will be awarded.

Grant Reporting: If selected, the grantee organization agrees to provide a post-project award report, including photos and possible video. The report must be submitted to the ADAF within one year of receiving the grant funds.

Application and Processing: All applications will be submitted through the ADAF online application site. All requested supporting documentation must be uploaded to the site by 11:59 p.m. CDT on April 26, 2019. Applicants will be notified in late July as to the status of their application.
