



GKAS Sign-up & Data System – NEW Features

Personal Username & Password

Gone are the days of having to recall your GKAS program user ID number! A key feature of the redesigned GKAS sign-up & data system is that your email address will become your username (if you are a past user) and you will be prompted to create your own personal password to enter into the GKAS system. And, if you forget your personal password the system will direct you to quickly and easily reset your password.

Program and Event Information Migrated

Once you've logged into the new system, you will see that your profile and past event information has been automatically transferred from the old GKAS data system into the new one. You will not need to re-enter your information, however, you will have the opportunity to update it if needed. In addition, events can now be cloned. This will be very beneficial if the type of event that you do stays the same, with the exception of the date changing.

Event Types

We understand that there is more than one type of GKAS event. Now when you go into the new GKAS sign-up & data system to enter your 2019 events, the system will ask you to indicate your event type. You will have the option to select from three event types. This will help you to better manage your events and it will help us to know what category your event falls under, particularly when assigning product kits.

Education Only

Volunteers provide oral health education only, with no other oral health services provided.

Education, Screening and Preventive Treatment

Volunteers provide oral health education, visual oral screening, and fluoride varnish applications. These types of events are likely not held in a clinical setting. Therefore, sealants and/or restorative treatments are not provided.

Education, Screening, and Preventive and Restorative Treatment

Volunteers provide oral health education, oral exam, X-rays, fluoride varnish, dental sealants, fillings, extractions and/or pulpotomies, etc. These events are likely to take place in a clinical setting (i.e., dental office or dental school).

Cost of Dental Services Provided

Manually calculating the cost of services provided for your GKAS event is a thing of the past. The updated GKAS sign-up & data system will now list the CDT codes for the dental services listed. When you enter the service provided during your event, the system will automatically calculate your total value of dental services provided. Fees are based on regional averages.

Patient Data

To assist you in capturing more extensive patient data, our new system now allows you to indicate the age, gender, ethnicity, and insurance status for your GKAS patients. You can go into the system at any time to review and edit your event and patient data.

Dentist Volunteer Information

You can now enter the dentist's ADA member number OR their first name and the first two letters of the last name and the system will automatically upload the remaining information (address, phone number and email). Non-dentist volunteers can also be manually entered into the system. Also, you can now pull a summary list of all your volunteers.

State Reports

The new system now allows dental associations and member dentists to pull GKAS summary reports at the state level. The reports can be created as a colorful infographic or an Excel spreadsheet highlighting the totals by state for the number of dentists and other volunteers, the total children serviced, total cost of services provided, and the number of screenings, preventive treatment, restorative treatment, and extractions. The reports can be printed and saved as a PDF.

GKAS Mobile App

The new GKAS mobile app is easy to install onto your mobile device. It allows you to enter individual patient data (during your event), manage volunteers and upload your GKAS event photos through your mobile device as your event is happening.

QR Code Capabilities

The machine-readable quick response code (QR code) will allow you to log into the new system without having to retype your username and password. QR codes are located on the desktop web application. Instructions will be provided regarding use.
